NOTICE REGARDING WELLNESS PROGRAM

The MSD of Wayne Township offers a voluntary wellness program available to all employees and spouses participating in the medical plan. The program is administered according to federal rules permitting employer-sponsored wellness programs that seek to improve employee health or prevent disease, including the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, the Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, as applicable, among others. If you choose to participate in the wellness program you will be asked to complete a voluntary health assessment that asks a series of questions about your health-related activities and behaviors and whether you have or had certain medical conditions (e.g., cancer, diabetes, or heart disease). You will also be asked to complete a biometric screening, which will include a blood test for Triglycerides (TG) and blood glucose as well as blood pressure and height/weight. You will also be asked to complete a health webinar (on either nutrition or stress management). You are not required to complete the Health Assessment, health webinar or to participate in the blood test or other medical examinations.

However, employees and spouses who choose to participate in the wellness program can receive incentives of a up to \$500 each in contributions into their Health Savings Account for completing the Health Assessment, health webinar and biometric screening. Although you are not required to complete any component of the program, only employees and spouses who do so will receive the contribution.

HSA contribution incentives may be available for employees and spouses who participate in certain health-related activities [individual goals/health coaching, monthly progress tracking and/or referrals] or achieve certain health outcomes [Body Mass Index (BMI 18.5-24.9), Blood Pressure <=120/80, Triglycerides <= 150mg/dL, Hemaglobin A1c <5.7% and obtaining all for biometrics in range]. If you are unable to participate in any of the health-related activities or achieve any of the health outcomes required to earn an incentive, you may be entitled to a reasonable accommodation or an alternative standard. You may request a reasonable accommodation or an alternative standard by contacting Human Resources at amy.eaton@wayne.k12.in.us

The results from your biometric screening will be used to provide you with information to help you understand your current health and potential risks, and may also be used to offer you services through the wellness program, such as health coaching. You also are encouraged to share your results or concerns with your own doctor.

Protections from Disclosure of Medical Information

We are required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your personally identifiable health information. Although the wellness program and MSD Wayne Township may use aggregate information it collects to design a program based on identified health risks in the workplace, the wellness program and onsite clinic will never disclose any of your personal information either publicly or to the employer, except as necessary to respond to a request from you for a reasonable accommodation needed to participate in the wellness program, or as expressly permitted by law. Medical information that personally identifies you that is provided in connection with the wellness program will not be provided to your supervisors or managers and may never be used to make decisions regarding your employment.

Your health information will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or otherwise disclosed except to the extent permitted by law to carry out specific activities related to the wellness program, and

you will not be asked or required to waive the confidentiality of your health information as a condition of participating in the wellness program or receiving an incentive. Anyone who receives your information for purposes of providing you services as part of the wellness program will abide by the same confidentiality requirements. The only individual(s) who will receive your personally identifiable health information is (are) members of the onsite clinic and Vital Incite in order to provide you with services under the wellness program.

In addition, all medical information obtained through the wellness program will be maintained separate from your personnel records, information stored electronically will be encrypted, and no information you provide as part of the wellness program will be used in making any employment decision. Appropriate precautions will be taken to avoid any data breach, and in the event a data breach occurs involving information you provide in connection with the wellness program, we will notify you immediately.

You may not be discriminated against in employment because of the medical information you provide as part of participating in the wellness program, nor may you be subjected to retaliation if you choose not to participate.
